

DESCRIPTION

A modern day version of the old African Log Drum that comes is several sizes. They include; a Soprano Drum, Alto Drum, Tenor Drum, Baritone Drum, Bass Drum, Contra Bass Drum, and a Sub-Contra Bass Drum.

The "H" pattern cut on top is two tonally separated notes not tuned to specific pitch, but have a properly descending order. All Log Drums have the added flexibility of achieving different tonal qualities by removing an adjustable stopper. For example, with the stopper removed, the Log Drum has an open punchy quality, and with the stopper left in, it has a subtle mellow tone.


The playing surface is Philippine Mahogany coated with a durable lustre finish that lends itself to a wide variety of mallet types and sizes for additional timbre and effects. The resonator is white pine and the two wood hues add contrast to the overall appearance of the instrument.

These percussion instruments are made to suit the desires and needs of the Musician and are available in combinations, arrays, or individually. Truly a must for the Percussionist who is continually expressing himself in the creative "Time Art" of Music.

NOMENCLATURE



Port: An open space that allows the tone

to propagate as the Drum is played.

Tongue: The actual striking surface that

creates the pitch.

Resonator: Augments or amplifies the

fundamental tone produced by the

tongue.

Stopper: An air tight plug that may be

removed for Timbre variations.

Stand: Suspends the instrument preventing

any occurance of damping to the

ground.

All Log Drums mounted in their respective stands have a playing surface height of 34".
